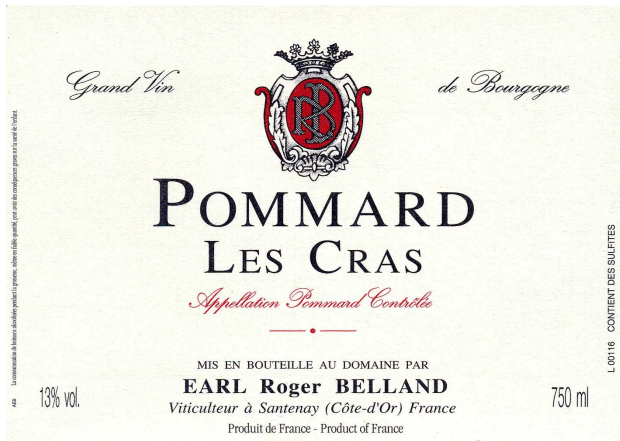




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POMMARD LES CRAS



The term « Les Cras » comes from the word « craie » (lime). This terroir is located near Volnay on a mild sloppy ground and its soil contains a large amount of limestone and stones.

During its vinification, this wine goes through a warm temperature final fermentation phase. This method enables to obtain a generous wine, blending elegance and power.

Characteristics

Grape variety: Exclusively 55 years old Pinot Noir vines

Surface area: 1 ha

Terroir: Stony clay-limestone soil

Working method: Vines sown with grass- leaves thinned out

Maturing: 1 year in French oak barrels- 50% new oak

Production: 5500 bottles/year

Dress: Purple garnet-red, deep and brilliant

Nose: Complex and powerful, blending red fruits, undergrowth and spices

Mouth: Spicy, very gourmand, rich in ripe grapes. A perfect blend of elegance and power

To be served with games like hare or wild bore, red meats or regional dishes like Coq au Vin or
